FARMLAND PRESERVATION GOOD NEWS!!

Recently, four more farms were preserved adding 430 more acres for a township total of 9,801 acres. 10,000 acres is getting closer week by week and, should be reached by this fall with thirteen farms approaching settlement.

Farms and their acreages recently preserved include Basile (27 acres), Coombs (114 acres), Greco (19 acres) and Stella #2 (269 acres). The Basile's own the Monroeville Winery which lies between two other preserved farms (DeEugenio and Cassaday). The Coombs farm is at the corner of Burlington and Garrison Roads. The Greco farm includes an adjoining 300 acres in Pittsgrove Township. And, the Stella farm now has over 600 acres preserved - almost one square mile in the center of the township.

State funding was becoming a concern for farmland preservation. Even though the voters approved taking 4% of the Corporate Business Tax for preservation, the governor vetoed attempts by the legislature to release the money because he wanted to use it to fix other holes in the state budget. However, because his next veto was likely to be overridden, he has agreed to let the funds be released. This will provide over \$70 million dollars a year.

As the leader of farmland preservation in New Jersey, other towns look to Upper Pittsgrove as a model for how to prevent the problems associated with sprawl and over-development.

Property Tax Reimbursement Program ~ PTR rebate

The filing deadline for the 2015 Senior Freeze (PTR)
Applications was extended to

OCTOBER 17, 2016

Seniors are eligible to apply for the first time at the age of 67.

Form PTR-1 is for applicants who are filing for a reimbursement the first time (or who filed an application the previous year that was denied for failure to meet all the eligibility requirements).

Form PTR-2 is a personalized application that is mailed only to those who filed an application and met all the eligibility requirements for a reimbursement the previous year.

If you qualify to use Form PTR-2, and you have not received a personalized application, call the Property Tax Reimbursement Hotline at 1-800-882-6597 to have one mailed to you.
