A \$250 deduction is available for qualified veterans or a surviving spouse of a veteran.

**ANOTHER 1,000 ACRES !!!**

Mayor Jack Cimprich reports that the past year has been exceptional! Having hit 10,000 acres a little over 12 months ago, the township is scheduled to pass the **11,000** acre mark by the end of July. Upper Pittsgrove continues to be number one out of 565 towns in New Jersey. Our township's rural quality of life will be guaranteed: low taxes, less traffic, less crime and pollution, and plenty of open space.

**THIS SERVICE IS LIMITED TO RESIDENTIAL IN APRIL AND OCTOBER ONLY !!!**

To be placed on the schedule call 358-0466 and leave a message with your name and address.

Service will be provided for normal, seasonal trimming of trees and shrubs. Brush **MUST BE** placed with cut ends to the edge of the road.

In event of a severe storm, brush and limbs may be chipped at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

## Property Tax Reimbursement Program ~ PTR rebate

The filing deadline for the 2017 Senior Freeze (PTR) Applications was extended to

**OCTOBER 31, 2018**

**Seniors are eligible to apply for the first time at the age of 67.**

**Form PTR-1** is for applicants who are filing for a reimbursement the first time (or who filed an application the previous year that was denied for failure to meet all the eligibility requirements).

**Form PTR-2** is a personalized application that is mailed only to those who filed an application and met all the eligibility requirements for a reimbursement the previous year.

If you qualify to use Form PTR-2, and you have not received a personalized application, call the Property Tax Reimbursement Hotline at 1-800-882-6597 to have one mailed to you.

## Construction Debris

**Small projects** —a 4'x8' pickup truck load is \$30.00, attic other cleanouts included. Heavier loads may be required to get weighed and then will be charged the current tipping fee. **Large projects** —You **MUST** obtain your own dumpster. All loads **SHOULD** be covered !
