Property Tax Reimbursement Program

PTR Rebate

The filing deadline for the 2021 Senior Freeze
(PTR) Applications was extended until

October 31, 2022

**Seniors are eligible to apply for the
first time at the age of 67.**

Form PTR-1 is for applicants who are filing
for a reimbursement the first time (or who
filed an application the previous year that
was denied for failure to meet all the
eligibility requirements).

Form PTR-2 is a personalized application
that is mailed only to those who filed an
application and met all the eligibility
requirements for a reimbursement the
previous year.

If you qualify to use Form PTR-2, and you
have not received a personalized
application, call the Property Tax
Reimbursement Hotline at 1-800-882-6597
to have one mailed to you.

THIS SERVICE IS LIMITED TO RESIDENTIAL IN APRIL AND OCTOBER ONLY !!!

To be placed on the schedule call 358-0466 and leave a message with your name and address.

Service will be provided for normal, seasonal trimming of trees and shrubs. Brush **MUST BE** placed with cut ends to the edge of the road.

In event of a severe storm, brush and limbs may be chipped at the discretion of the Public Works Department.

FARMLAND PRESERVATION

Great Progress this Past Year!!

Upper Pittsgrove has now preserved 11,891 acres of farmland – 501 acres more than a year ago. There are currently 9 more farms awaiting settlement for another 340 acres.

Farms and their acres about to be preserved include: Dickinson (26), Hamilton (38), Kessel (50), Manchester (25), Mercer (35), Spokony (20), Stimpson (54), Valentine (52) and Zeck (40).

Upper Pittsgrove continues to be number one out of 565 towns in the state for farmland preservation. And, because of our success, we have lower taxes, less traffic and pollution, and plenty of open space for recreation and a quality of life other towns can only envy.
